PASCHA, AGAPE VESPERS & PICNIC

Return on Sunday to continue the Paschal celebration at **1:00 pm for Agape Vespers** where the Gospel is read in many languages.

After Agape Vespers there will be a picnic and egg hunt. The hunt begins at 3:00 pm. and has four age categories:

- ***Toddler/Preschool**
- ***Elementary School**
- ***Junior & High School**
- ***Adult**
