<u>ANTIOCHIAN WOMEN'S (AW)</u> <u>ONGOING PROJECT FOR WIDOWED</u> <u>KHOURIAS</u>

The 2023-2024 AW project was devoted to "helping widows in their affliction" as they sought to establish an endowment fund to benefit our beloved widowed clergy-wives. The initial goal of \$150,00 was surpassed by generous donations, including from this parish, and they raised \$395,712! Metropolitan Saba has given his blessing for the AW to continue through 2026 to raise funds for this endowment to reach a goal of \$1,000,000. Though that seems large, it will form the principal and will not be touched. Just the yearly dividends will be used to grant financial support. Divided among our widowed Khourias, the money will only provide a modest gift. The larger the endowment, the more there will be to substantially contribute to the care of our widowed Khourias.
