## WE NEED YOUR INPUT!

### **Option #1 ~ \$30,000**

- Installing stone paver walkways connection to the north and south parking lot walkways  
–*Minimum required for County permits*  
–Includes labor, additional materials (pavers already purchased), disposal costs, equipment rental, and lighting

### **Option #2 ~ additional \$30,000**

- Option #1 plus...  
–Create welcoming patio area between north parking lot, Narthex, & fellowship hall while preserving the rose garden  
–Labor & materials, including additional pavers

So far we have raised \$25,650, getting us close to covering Option #1. If we are to continue to beautify the entrance to the church responsibly, we will need to fundraise the remainder. The amount raised will determine what we are able to accomplish. Please vote with your pocketbooks!
